PENTECOST CELEBRATES THE POWER OF THE **HOLY SPIRIT & BIRTH OF CHRISTIANITY**

The Feast of Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and other followers of Jesus while they were in Jerusalem 50 days after Easter. This day is important to all Christians as it is celebrated as the day the Christian Church was born.

This important event is outlined in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2:1–31) which states that:

"The Apostles and other believers were all gathered in a room praying steadfastly, when what sounded like a mighty, rushing wind, filled the room and then, tongues of fire appeared and rested upon each of them and they were filled with the Holy Spirit which gave them the power to do amazing things they could not do before.

They began to speak in many different languages as the Holy Spirit gave them the power to do so. Jews and Gentiles who had gathered for a religious feast day celebration in Jerusalem; who had come from Judea, Mesopotamia, Asia, Egypt, Libya, Rome, Crete and Arabia all heard their own language being spoken.

Those who heard them wondered what this meant. others mocked them believing they were drunk. Peter, filled with the transforming power of the Holy Spirit, preached a powerful message of Jesus' love and salvation, converting over three thousand to Christianity"

Let us pray for the Gifts of the Holy Spirit to transform our lives.


