

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## **After School Clubs**

OUR AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS ARE FULLY UP AND RUNNING. WE ASK THAT CHILDREN OBSERVE THE SAME GOLDEN RULES WHICH ARE IN PLACE ALL ACROSS THE SCHOOL. THESE ARE:

- 1. I will respect everybody and everything at all times
- 2. I will keep myself and others safe at all times.
- 3. I will follow instructions immediately at all times.
- 4. I will do my best at all times.

All our children are asked to be in full compliance with these rules in class and in all clubs as by doing so they keep themselves and others safe. Children who do not respectfully observe these rules will be asked NOT to return to clubs by staff leading our Out of Hours School Programmes .... self -discipline is required of all.

\*Children left late after clubs habitually will be placed in our MAE programme and parents charged for their supervision at the same rate(£5)- that is paid by our MAE parentswho are signed up for this service. So....please be prompt with pick ups after clubs each day. Thank You.
