#### GOD'S LOVE...Manifested At Epiphany

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> Jan. we celebrated the Feast of The Epiphany



The word EPIPHANY comes from a Greek word meaning manifestation or revelation. For many Christians, Epiphany refers to the revelation of the Divine nature of Jesus to all and is marked by a Feast day celebrated on January 6<sup>th</sup> annually across the world. For many Christians in Eastern Europe, Latin America, East Africa and the Mediterranean the Feast of The Epiphany or Feast of Kings is their Christmas! Additionally, the word "Epiphany" has another popular meaning: a sudden burst of understanding or insight. When the Magi visited the Christ Child they had an Epiphany-the Holy Spirit revealed the importance and significance of Jesus for the world to them and they were filled with awe. They went away to teach others these Truths:

>Always seek God who is the truth and the light >If you follow the light of Christ you will never be lost >Do not be deterred by those who would lead you astray-some have their own agenda- like Herod did when he asked the Wise Men to come back to him so that he too could go and "pay homage" to Jesus

>Pray for the spirit of discernment so that you will always act in line with God's plans for you

>Do not miss the message that God is revealing to you daily-messages come in many forms via: the Holy Scriptures, Good Advice and Example, Visions & Nature

>Once you have found Jesus...walk closely with Him daily and you won't go wrong! >Wise men, women and children still seek Jesus today. Are you seeking his hope, joy and peace? During the Holy Season of Christmas we all try to be a bit kinder to family and friends; why not extend this effort all year long in 2023?

-What was the problem in the story and how was it solved?

-Did the character change during the story? How? -How are you like the main character? How are you different?

-What do you predict will happen next in the story? -Why do you think the author chose this title for the story?

-Do you like the title of the story? Why or why not? -Can you think of a different title for the story? Which character from the story would you choose to be your friend? Why?

-Which part of the story was the most exciting? Why? -Did you like the end of the story? Why or why not? -Which parts in the story could really happen? Which parts could not really happen?
