
Lent is a time of Spiritual Transformation: Let's



The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday. We will gather as a school along with our brothers and sisters at St Bonaventure's 6<sup>th</sup> Form to celebrate this Holy Mass together with you, our parents and faith community members who come out to worship with the children and staff of the school to mark the beginning of this most solemn season. During Lent we are reminded of Jesus' love for His Heavenly Father and for us all. We recall his encounter with the devil at a point when he was at his most human (tired, weak and hungry). We know that He did this to show to us that we too can overcome any temptation that the devil places before us even in times of weakness. If we remain strong in our faith in God and in our knowledge and faith in the Holy Scriptures, we have the fuel to strengthen our spirits.

Jesus went into the wilderness to fast and pray to model for us how we should prepare ourselves for any major mission or ministry that we will undertake in our lives as Christians. There is a caution that we should not fast merely out of obligation or ritual but rather for strengthening our bodies, minds and souls. We can fast for a purpose or we can fast from bad habits, attitudes and thinking.
