



## Important Information Regarding Our Phased Return

### **St Antony's Begins Its Phased Return To School Process the week beginning Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 for specific groups.**

Following Government Guidance and Rigorous Risk Assessments the school will begin to open for an extended range of staff and children

- Starting with staff who are able to return during week of June 1<sup>st</sup>
- Followed by year 6 pupils the week beginning June 8<sup>th</sup> 2020
- Then opening for year 1 pupils the week beginning June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020

Staff able to return will come into school to plan and prepare for the safe phased return of pupils **from years 1 and 6 only** - until further notice.

Based on our **RISK ASSESSMENTS** we are not able to facilitate children from our Early Years at this time so **NO** Viridis, Nursery or Reception children will be facilitated for now.

**Parents have the choice as to whether they send their children in or not as the phased return is not mandatory at this time.**

We will still continue to support children of our **Critical Key Workers and those on our Vulnerable Children's list**. Children of Doctors, Nurses, Police, Fire Fighters, Ambulance & Emergency workers etc. who are still working on the front line in the fight to eradicate COVID-19 will be accommodated. However, even if you belong to this group of CRITICAL KEY WORKERS **but you or your partner is off work and at home** you are asked to keep your child/children who are not in year 6 or year 1 at home with you as this is still the safest action for all.

If your child falls under the heading of **'vulnerable child'** and has a social worker, **keep in touch with your Social Worker** for advice and guidance as needed. If necessary, they will continue to assess your situation and work with you to agree the best option(s) for your child at this time and going forward.
