



St Antony's Catholic Primary School Remote Home Learning Guidelines for Pupils



ATTENTION ALL PUPILS OF ST ANTONY'S

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic, you will be using our online platforms for learning now and in the future to access not only homework but also your daily classwork set by your teachers for online lessons. This will happen whenever National Lockdown procedures are put in place by the Government or if your year group bubble has to close. In light of these facts, we ask that you read carefully, understand and follow the guidelines below to ensure that you stay safe and keep your friends and others safe at all times.

As a pupil at St Antony's, I want to keep myself safe online. I know that anything I do on the computer, phone, tablet or internet, while I am at home may be seen by someone else that I don't know. So, I am promising that I will:

- Only visit websites and open pages which my parent, carer or teacher has said are okay
- Talk to my parent, carer or teacher before using anything on the internet that I am not sure about
- Tell my parent, carer or teacher if anything or anyone online makes me feel scared, unsafe or uncomfortable
- Make sure that all the messages I send to my teachers and comments I post are polite and positive
- Tell my parent, carer or teacher if I get a nasty message or something that makes me feel uncomfortable or unsafe from anyone- and I will not reply
- Not give my phone number or address to anyone online.
- Not tell people about myself online (I will not tell them my name, anything about where I live or where I go to school or the names of clubs that I attend)
- Not upload photographs of myself onto the computer or internet without my parent or carer's permission to do so
- keep any passwords that I have- private
- Only speak to people I know online and on the phone.
- Never agree to share photos, phone numbers, do face time/ take video calls or meet anyone that I or my family do not know.
- Always make sure my parent/carer knows who I am talking to or messaging.

When Using Class Dojo, Zoom or Google Classroom:

- When using Class Dojo, Zoom or Google Classroom to do work, the teacher may or may not let me or other pupils make comments
- If I am allowed to comment, I will remember to use our learning on online behaviour and **be polite and positive** making sure that my comments are on the learning activities or discussions as teachers can see who is commenting.
